July Featured Artist



Josephina DiSalvo – Photographer/Artist

A self taught multi-awarded photojournalist for over 35 years, Josephina prints conventional and unconventional images in variety: on canvas, archival matte, film, silver gelatin, or whatever serves the image. “I photograph what I see or imagine is there. I pursue colors and rhythm. For me, the camera and print process is interchangeable with pen, paintbrush and keyboard.”

From her debut in Greece, Josephina has been reviewed as distinctively unique. “My Crete, my Milatos...” the internationally

famous exhibit was filmed, broadcast and displayed in the Heraklion Municipal Androgeo on Crete. Josephina’s diversified family portraits were the highlight of “Familien Portraits” on site of the Berlin Wall and in Moscow. Her “Sea Whimsies” echo a solitary childhood immersed in literature and nature. Titles like “Wheee” is a child’s Naïveté’ of a deadly sting while capturing the creature’s whimsical beauty. “Photographing nature and geometric forms is empowering. Thru a lens, the world becomes evocative.”

Josephina’s education includes CSU Northridge where she majored in Art & Creative Writing, completed coursework in music at UCLA, general studies at Missouri Southern College, and Abstract Painting with internationally acclaimed artist, Annie Wharton. Josephina’s images have been printed and filmed in multiple publications and venues. Her works are in private collections in Europe, Puerto Rico, Guatemala, Greece, and throughout the U.S. Josephina is also a member of Women in Photography International, San Pedro Art Association, Long Beach Arts, Vista Art Foundation/Gallery 204, Clairemont Art Guild, San Dieguito Art Guild and Carlsbad Art Surf Committee. TREASURER'S MESSAGE – JULY 2009

Brushmark Delivery – With our weak economy, 2009 is proving to be a tough year financially for COAL. To help control expenses, we are changing the way we distribute the monthly *Brushmark*. This will result in significant savings in printing and mailing costs. The current issue (July) will be the last issue mailed to all members by the USPS. Beginning with the August issue, all members that have provided us with an email address will receive their newsletter by email. Members who do not have an email address, or have chosen not to share it with us, will continue to receive their newsletter by the USPS. The newsletter will also be posted on our new website; www.coalartgallery.com for all members to access should anyone lose their emailed or USPS mailed copy. There are only about 40 members who have not provided us with an email address. If you have an email, please share it with us. It will help us reduce costs and make communicating with you much more efficient.

Gallery Renovation Plans – Despite the weak economy, we are pushing ahead with our gallery renovation now that we have a firm 5 year lease. The renovation involves a new exterior sign (installed in 2008), new lighting, new floor covering, and perhaps some other minor changes. The changes will give our gallery a brighter, more up-to-date look and we expect to save on electricity and carpet cleaning. Here is where we stand:

- **Lighting** – New lighting has been ordered and delivered. It should be installed before the take-in for the July show.
- **Flooring** – New flooring has been selected. It will be a vinyl plank flooring that resembles wood. It is waterproof and will be easier and less costly to keep clean. The pale blond color will warm and brighten the gallery. We are now in the process of inviting some vendors to give us quotes for installation.

Flooring Installation Schedule - So as not to cause disruption during the summer when customer traffic is generally higher, we are delaying the flooring installation until fall. The gallery will have to be closed for a week, (most likely the first week in November). To insure that no monthly show is less than 4 weeks long the November show, while starting a week later, will still be a 4 week show and the December show will be reduced from 5 weeks to 4 weeks. We will publish a revised calendar for you well in advance of the planned installation.

You Can Help – We have made every effort to identify quality products for our gallery while, at the same time, being as frugal as possible with our financial resources. However, the cost will be higher than we anticipated and it will draw down our emergency funds lower than we would like to have them unless we can get some help. You can help us keep our emergency fund at a safe level by making a small donation to assist with funding the renovation. Our goal is to raise \$2,500. We have already received donations from some members and we thank you! In this economy, it is difficult for us to ask members for help but **if every member donated just \$10, we can meet our goal.** Your help will be greatly appreciated.
