The Carlsbad Oceanside Art League ("COAL" or the "League") is a non-profit organization the purpose of which is to promote the education and cultural appreciation of fine arts in the community. This purpose shall be supported, as funding allows, by demonstrations, student scholarships, outdoor displays, exhibitions, commercial displays, miscellaneous cultural tours, and a main gallery. (Paraphrased from the League Bylaws).

### THINGS YOU SHOULD CONSIDER BEFORE JOINING COAL

League Activities and Services: A month-long show in our gallery each month; a monthly demonstration meeting at the Calavara Hills Recreation Center in Carlsbad; a monthly newsletter, *The Brushmark*; an annual yearbook and roster of members, which includes bylaws and other pertinent information; several annual award shows for members as well as children and students of the local community; sponsorship of a weekly outdoor show in front of the Carlsbad Inn (for qualifying members).

Yes, the League does many things for its members and for the community but it is, after all, a *cooperative organization*. Thus, it expects its members to assume certain individual responsibilities, to wit:

- Pay dues annually and on time (except for Life Members)
- Advise the Director of Membership of a significant change to any of the pertinent information solicited on the front of this form.
- Become familiar with the standard operating procedures of the gallery by reading the available material and complying with these procedures while serving as gallery attendant.
- Fulfill gallery hosting obligations without fail, or provide a substitute host at your own expense (typically \$20 per three hours).
- Whenever possible, volunteer for open positions on the Board of Directors or for committee work as may be required from time to time.
- Support the League by showing artwork at least three (3) times a year in the gallery.

Of these, the most important is to fulfill your hosting obligations. When you bring artwork to the gallery for display each month, you obligate yourself to be the gallery attendant -- to greet and assist customers, make sales, etc., -- normally for just one 3-hour day session if you bring in 3 pieces or fewer, and two 3-hour sessions if you bring in more than 3 pieces. You pick your own duty period from those available when you bring in your work (generally, the first Monday of each month). But, once chosen, it is your responsibility to either host at the gallery as scheduled, find someone to swap with, or provide a substitute (who must be a League member) at your own expense. If you feel you cannot do this then, please, do not join (or, at least, don't enter work in a month you are not able to be a host). If you do, you won't be happy, and neither will we.

Beyond the above criteria, we invite you to find out about how we operate -- how our activities are run and what our policies and procedures are. The latter of these are covered in some detail in a ***Procedures Manual*** at the Gallery that is available for your inspection. And of course, the League member on duty can answer your questions as well. **One important policy that you should be aware of is that we don't accept crafts for display in the Gallery or at any League venue.** Our procedures manual goes into some detail on what is acceptable. Please familiarize yourself with it in advance. We don't want you to be disappointed after you join!
