IT'S TIME TO RENEW COAL 2019 MEMBERSHIP

COAL is looking forward to an artistic and productive 2019. In 2018, we gave out more than \$5000 in cash awards. Thank you to those of you who entered the shows. Special congratulations to those of you who won those cash prizes. Your continued membership is important to the Gallery. Without your participation our doors would not open and award shows would not be possible.

COAL has kept dues increases to a minimum. Our dues remain lower than other galleries in the area. Your participation in the monthly shows has made this possible. The 2019 dues remain the same as last year and are due by January 31, 2019 and considered delinquent after March 1, 2019. Renewal rates are \$87 for individuals, \$30 for students, \$109 for joint members and \$700 for life members. Patron Members are a minimum of \$100.
