Congratulations to new COAL member and Best of Show winner, John Glowe, for his oil painting "Wild at Heart." All the ribbon winners in our other categories are to be congratulated as well. Thanks to all members for their participation. Shuang Li, our judge, gave a wonderful demonstration of her watermedia techniques to a crowd of 75. We appreciate your attendance and hope you will watch for our events in the future.



Artists know that galleries "come-and-go" and I want COAL members to know that we have just entered into a new lease so we will be here for that duration. That renewal has caused the COAL Board to require an increase in our dues beginning with 2018. Dues are increasing \$1.00 per month, or \$12.00 annually. The individual dues for 2018 are \$87 (no discount for early payment). Throughout the years COAL has maintained operations and kept our dues reasonable and continues to do so. This increase is necessary, yet below other galleries. We will NOT be changing our monthly per-item entry fee.

Members, please attend the COAL Annual Meeting Saturday, December 9th, from 1-3PM, at the Gallery. As in past years this event includes a pot-luck luncheon. This is an opportunity for members to learn about plans for 2018 as well as member-input and questions of the Board. Please plan to attend. December is our "Small Treasures" Show-in-Show (SIS). All mediums will be judged together for cash prizes. Maximum Size – 14 inches on longest side including frame. For a sculpture, 14 inches on longest direction.

In spite of annual rent and utility increases, over the years the dues increases have been nominal until this year. Our 2018 Gallery rent has a major increase. The lease negotiations were lengthy making it impossible for us to offer an early payment dues discount. We hope you understand this is the reason for the substantial dues increase and no early payment discount.

I'm thrilled to announce that four of our members have stepped up and volunteered for Board positions. Thank you to Debi Krichbaum, Membership Show Director; Char Cee Colosia, Children's Show Director; Carol "Grace" Shelley, Hospitality chair and Sarah Strand, Website Gatekeeper. IT'S TIME TO RENEW MEMBERSHIP

COAL is looking forward to an artistic and productive 2018. In 2017, we gave out more than \$5000 in cash awards. Thank you to those of you who entered the shows. Special congratulations to those of you who won those cash prizes. Your continued membership is important to the Gallery. Without your participation our doors would not open and award shows would not be possible.

The 2018 membership fee has been increased by \$1 a month or \$12 dollars a year. In spite of annual rent and utility increases we have not raised the dues until now by more than nominal amounts. COAL has kept dues increases to a minimum and we remain below other galleries. The 2018 dues are due by January 31, 2018 and considered delinquent after March 1, 2018. Renewal rates are \$87 for individuals, \$30 for students, \$109 for joint members and \$700 for life members.
